Economic Contribution of Southern Minnesota Beet Sugar Cooperative

Southern Minnesota Beet Sugar Cooperative, located in Renville, is a major beet sugar extraction cooperative. Given its sugarbeet production and extraction role, Southern Minnesota Beet Sugar Cooperative (SMBSC) wanted to understand its contribution to the regional and state economy. SMBSC hired University of Minnesota Extension to conduct the study.



- Farmer owned cooperative established in 1972
- 500 Shareholders with farm operations in 17 counties
- 350 Full-time employees and 450 seasonal employees
- Operating the largest beet plant in the United States

PRODUCTION AND EXTRACTION



- Minnesota is the #1 sugarbeet producing state (tons produced)
- Minnesota accounts for 35% of national sugarbeet production
- Total sugarbeet production is increasing
- Half of the United State's sugar production comes from sugarbeets
